- Applicant must complete the application and submit it along with narrative (see below) before the deadline.

Restrictions

- Current UCDA Board of Directors and UCDA Foundation Board of Directors are not eligible to receive a scholarship.
- If a recipient is unable to attend the summit, UCDA may select another recipient.
- This is not a cash scholarship, but will cover the summit registration fee; up to two nights lodging at the host hotel (if needed); and up to \$300 that can be used towards travel.

3. What professional areas do you feel you most need to develop?
4. How will attending the summit benefit your professional growth?

Deadline

All applications must be returned to the UCDA Home Office no later than March 1.
